Application and Fee must be received by **July 1, 2025**, and are NON-REFUNDABLE. Pay by credit card, US Currency-Money Order, Certified Check or Business check. Personal checks are not accepted. Payment by Visa or Master Card can be arranged by calling (631) 283-6143 ext. 109 after you have returned your signed contract. There is a service fee. We do not accept payments at other Powwows or locations. Please mail vendor application (with photos of merchandise), fee and proof of tribal affiliation to the address above. Fees include:

- Electric hook up of 20 amps max: All vendors are required to bring their own lighting (LED bulbs) you may bring a quiet motor generator
- Extension cords must be suitable for OUTSIDE use with a minimum of 16-gauge 3 prong
- Vendor spaces are limited to 10 feet across or 20 feet across
- Only 2 vehicles behind your stand

Food vendors are required to prominently display a valid Food Handler's Certificate. The person whose name is on the certificate must be present during stand operations.

All stands must be set up and cars removed from the grounds by 2:00 pm on Friday. Late arrivals must be set up by 9:00 am Saturday. THURSDAY IS THE PREFERED SET UP DAY

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Please respect the following:

- You may not sell hotdogs, hamburgers, or soda
- There is NO subletting of booth space
- Vendors must keep the grounds in front and near their booths clear of trash
- There will be an additional \$50 fee charged if the fence behind your booth is cut for any reason
- No pet, Alcohol, Drugs, Weapons, or Sales Tax Collection
- No metal tipped arrows, slingshots, whips, medicine masks, stabilized turquoise, cigarettes, candy, film, glow-in-the-dark items, headdress, feather headbands, no plastic/wood bow and arrows
- No card, palm, or other readings
- No "sale" half price" "wholesale" or similar pricing signage is permitted
- No Vapes or THC products
- NO raffles at vendor stands

The Shinnecock Powwow Committee reserves the right to have any vendor remove an item or cease any demonstration deemed inappropriate. Failure to comply will result in a vendor being asked to leave and his/her payment will be forfeited.

The Shinnecock Indian Nation, the Shinnecock Presbyterian Church, Shinnecock Council of Trustees, and/or Powwow Committee are not responsible for personal loss, injury and/or damage to property. We practice zero tolerance to alcohol and drug use on our powwow grounds.
