A letter can be furnished in lieu of a federal tax exemption determination letter that states the following: The Shinnecock Indian Nation is an Indian tribal government that is treated as a State pursuant to Section 7871 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("IRC"). As such, it is a "governmental unit" as defined in IRC Sections 170(b)(1)(A)(v) and 170(c)(1) and is not a private foundation by virtue of IRC Section 509(a)(1). All charitable donations made to the Shinnecock Indian Nation will be tax deductible.
